Format:

- 4 teams of 6
- 5 v 5, + 1 goalie each
- 1 v 2, 3 v 4
- 1 v 4, 2 v 3
- 1 v 3, 2 v 4
- 1st v 4th, 2nd v 3rd
- Winners vs Winners, Non-winners vs Non-
- 8 minute games
- Transfer time
